Dr. Hallstrom serves as the Founding Director of Florida Atlantic University's Institute for Sensing and Embedded Network Systems Engineering (I-SENSE), and is a Professor in the Department of Computer Engineering, Electrical Engineering, and Computer Science. He holds a B.S. in Systems Analysis, an M.A in Economics, and M.S. and Ph.D. degrees in Computer and Information Science. His expertise is in the design, deployment, and management of large-scale wireless sensing infrastructure, with an emphasis on hardware/software co-design. His work has contributed to 126 publications, 156 presentations, and resulted in multiple awards. Dr. Hallstrom's work is currently supported through the National Science Foundation, NOAA (via CCU), the Knight Foundation, the City of West Palm Beach, and industry partners. He was previously supported through the NSF, DOE, EPA, USDA, NASA, industry partners, and other entities. He received the CAREER award from the National Science Foundation in 2008.
